The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.63, dated 3.7.2015, registered under Sections 406/380/448/120B of the IPC, at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the complainant is actually a resident of Canada and has gone back after lodging the present FIR. However, the petitioners are absolutely willing to settle the dispute as was indicated on the last date.

Learned Addl. A.G Punjab, on instructions from HC Rupinder Singh, has accepted that the complainant has gone abroad.

In the circumstances, it is directed that in the event of their

arrest, the petitioners be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. This will, however, be subject to the condition that once the complainant comes back, both the parties would act as per the compromise.

The petition stands disposed of.
