The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.211 dated 28.05.2015, registered under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC) at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonipat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The cheques, amounting to Rs.5,90,000/-, given by the petitioner as surety and guarantee, to the complainant which were required to be encashed only in case the

friends of the petitioner namely Sandeep Kumar and Ravinder got selected in government job of Postman. But the complainant had presented these cheques for encashment without providing job to the friends of the petitioner, which were dishonoured. Thereafter, the complainant has lodged the present FIR by alleging that the said amount was borrowed from him by the petitioner for some personal use.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel as well as the learned counsel for the complainant oppose the bail and state that the petitioner issued cheques amounting to Rs.5,90,000/- under fake signatures to the complainant which was dishonored. Therefore, the petitioner is not entitled for the bail.

Heard.

Admittedly the cheques in question were issued by the petitioner, however, there is nothing on record to suggest that the cheques were issued in lieu of providing job to the friends of the petitioner. Moreover, the signatures on the aforesaid cheques were found to be fake by the bank authorities.

Keeping in view the role of the petitioner, no case for bail is made out.

Dismissed.
