Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.415 dated 08.09.2014, under Sections 376, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 498-A, 506, 323, 328 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sarai, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. her son and husband who had faced the trial were acquitted by the trial Court vide judgment dated 27.07.2015 (Annexure P-1). Petitioner is the mother-in-law of the complainant and is ready to face the trial.
