This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner vide FIR No.173 dated 20.07.2014 under Sections 498-A and 323 IPC at Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel seeks to place on record status report by way of affidavit of Bal Krishan Singla, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, South, Amritsar, on behalf of respondent No.1. Prayer is accepted. Affidavit is taken on record.

According to stand of the State, petitioner is not entitled to concession of pre-arrest bail in view of serious nature of allegations levelled against him. He is stated to be involved in certain other cases, details of which are given in Para 2 of the affidavit.

Under the circumstances, petitioner is not entitled to discretionary relief of pre-arrest bail. He is, however, relegated to the remedy of filing a representation in terms of judgment titled as *Arnesh Kumar versus State of Bihar and another, 2014(3) R.C.R. (Crl.) 527*.
