The instant petition has been filed for quashing of order dated 02.07.2014 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Jalandhar whereby appeal filed by petitioners against order dated 20.03.2014 (Annexure P-2) passed by JMIC, Jalandhar was dismissed.

The matter was sent to the Mediation Centre of this Court and the parties have entered into a settlement. As per the terms of settlement parties have resumed cohabitation. It is specifically recorded in the settlement that the instant petition seeking to

challenge the order dated 02.07.2014 be allowed.

In view of the aforesaid and the terms of settlement, the instant petition is allowed and the impugned orders dated 20.03.2014 (Annexure P-2) and 02.07.2014 (Annexure P-3) are set aside.

It is made clear that the parties shall remain bound by the other terms of the settlement reached before the Mediator.
