The allegations against the petitioner-Lakha Singh son of Manohar Singh in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.99 dated 11.08.2014 at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, Amritsar, under Sections 307/452/323/324/120-B/148/149 of IPC are that on 10th August, 2014, he along with his co-accused had assaulted three persons who received injuries. As per prosecution, petitioner had given a gandas blow from reverse side on the back of right shoulder of Varinder Singh son of the complainant-Lakha Singh son of Puran Singh and which is opined to be simple in nature.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner

that the petitioner is in custody for ten months and that has not been controverted by learned State Counsel on the instructions from ASI Amarjeet Singh, Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, Amritsar.

Taking into consideration the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner coupled with the fact that the trial will take a long time to conclude, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is not warranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of trial Court.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
