The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 for the quashing of FIR No.38, dated 06.03.2007, under Sections 324, 323, 341, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran, along with all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

The report of learned Addl. Distt & Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran has been received. It is reported that the statements of complainant/injured Nishan Singh, injured Roop Singh as well as accused Kulwant Singh, Jang Kumar, Hira Singh, Tarsem Singh, Jassa Singh, Harchand Singh, Baldev Raj, Gurchet Kumar and

Lakhwinder Kumar have been recorded, which show that the parties have entered into a compromise voluntarily and want to live peacefully.

Since the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled, therefore, the FIR in question along with all the consequential proceedings stand quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
