JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner Ishwar Chand in the complaint case emerging out the FIR No.71 dated 22.04.2011 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC registered with Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

It is submitted that the allegations pertain to violation of Rule 3.48 of the Punjab Land Records Manual read with Rule 71 of the Land Revenue Rules relating to distribution of compensation for the acquired Shamlat Land to the proprietors/share holders on the basis of list of proprietors prepared by the Patwari/Kanguho of the office of Tehsildar Kalka.

It is contended that no doubt the petitioner was posted as

Tehsildar Kalka at the relevant time, however, the list of proprietors was prepared by the Kanguho as per the available revenue records and after due investigation a cancellation report was submitted by the investigating agency, however, on the mere statement of protest, the learned Magistrate without application of mind has taken cognizance and summoned the petitioner in the complaint case.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the previous order dated 02.09.2015, petitioner had surrendered himself before the trial Court and he had been granted interim/pre-arrest bail.

Learned State Counsel does not refute the aforesaid contention.

In view of the above, interim/pre arrest bail so granted by the trial Court stands confirmed.

Petition stands disposed of.
