Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass him at the instance of private respondent Nos.6 to 10, who happen to be his brother, his father, his sons and his wife.

As per the allegations, petitioner has differences with his family members and despite the fact that he has injunction against two of the private respondents i.e. respondent Nos.8 and 9, the private respondents continuously manhandle him, beat him and forcibly lodged him in de-addiction centre and the police is not taking any action.

On 04.09.2015 following order was passed:

“Notice to respondents No.3 to 5 be issued with the direction to personally appear before this Court along with records on 21.09.2015.”

Respondents No.3 and 5 have appeared. Respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, has stated that the facts are that the petitioner has an alcohol problem and one of his brothers is exploiting that because he has as an eye on the valuable property of the petitioner, and the private respondents who are his immediate family members are rather trying to help the petitioner in overcoming his unhealthy dependence. He has also stated that every time the petitioner has complained, action has been taken and rather two FIRs have been lodged against the respondents No.8 and 9. He states that he would issue instructions to respondent No.5 to take necessary action to restrain the private respondent/respondents from any illegal activity.

In view of the statement of the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, present petition is disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
