Report dated 24.3.2015 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Shiv Parsad, Kamalkant Tiwari and Indu Tiwari as well as of complainant Mamta Pandey it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties having matrimonial dispute compromised the matter and that the compromise will go a long way to settle their life and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.80 dated 28.12.2012 under Section 406 and 498-A IPC Police Station, Women Cell, Jalandhar City and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
