Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.105 dated 19.07.2015, under Sections 323, 186, 353, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 307, 332, 333 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 31.08.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners were initially arrested and were released on bail. However, offence under Section 307 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 was added at a later stage.

Notice of motion for 05.10.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioners be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under

Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Jaswant Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 31.08.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
