Report dated 19.09.2015 sent by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sunam (Sangrur) has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Anwar Khan @ Babla as well as of complainant Sat Pal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.14 dated 01.02.2015 under Sections 354-A IPC and Section 66-A and 67-A of the Information Technology Act, 2000 Police Station,

Cheema District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
