The petitioner is a girl who seeks quashing of FIR No.55 dated 11.06.2013 under Sections 363, 366-A, 368, 376 read with Section 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur on the basis of compromise.

In the aforesaid FIR, complainant Raksha Rani-respondent No.2 alleged that respondent No.3 went missing at night and she saw respondent No.3 being taken by Sukha towards the fields. Petitioner is sister of said Sukha. Since partial quashing is not an appropriate step in this case, being a case under Section 376 IPC, I do not deem it appropriate to entertain the petition for quashing especially when main accused is not a party.

Petition is dismissed.

However, it is observed that in case supplementary statement of complainant exonerates the petitioner, it will be open to the investigating agency to drop proceedings against the petitioner. It will also be open to her to approach this Court again.
