Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.110 dated 23.09.2011, under Sections 326, 323, 324, 148, 149 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sri Hargobindpur, District Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise.

The petitioners were booked at the instance of respondent No.2 Chanchal Singh alleging that petitioners on 21.09.2011 armed with various weapons allegedly attacked the

complainant. Grievous injury is also attributed to the petitioners. Statements of complainant Chanchal Singh and his wife Lakhwinder Kaur (injured) have already been recorded.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been sent to this Court intimating that the matter has been compromised voluntarily, without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
