Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 84 dated 25.10.2012, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Jasvir Kaur alleging that a sum of Rs. 2 lacs had been obtained fraudulently from her by the petitioners for sending her to Canada on work visa.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
