FIR stands quashed against Ramesh Kumar, brother of applicant- Deepak Kumar. Initially, the petition was filed by the mother of present applicant for quashing the FIR and it is submitted that Deepak Kumar was not made a party as he was living separately from his mother and had not joined hands with her for filing the petition. On the last date, time was sought for filing an application to implead Deepak Kumar husband of complainant- Pooja. Deepak Kumar is also co-accused with his mother Kailash Wanti.

Application is allowed. Deepak Kumar is impleaded as petitioner No.2.

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This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No.1264 dated 5.12.2014 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station City Panipat on basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Complainant-Pooja is present with her husband Deepak Kumar, who has been impleaded as party today. She submits that she is living with her husband and they have a male child who is 5 years old. The child is also present in the Court with the parents. The complainant has replied on query made by the Court since the marriage has been saved and she is living happily with her husband, she does not want to take any action against the husband or mother-in-law. She has no objection if the FIR in question is quashed.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the abovesaid FIR and the proceedings connected therewith are hereby quashed.

Disposed of.
