Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the Negotiable Instruments (Amendment) Ordinance, 2015 has been issued which was published in the Gazette Notification dated 15.6.2015 making certain amendments including Section 142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act relating to the territorial jurisdiction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to raise all the contentions taken herein before the trial Court at the appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

After the petitioner appears before the trial Court and furnishes the bail bonds, the petitioner would be at liberty to apply for exemption. The trial Court would consider the application sympathetically but in accordance with law and ensure that no delay is caused in disposal of the case in case the exemption is allowed.
