FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 09.07.2014 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioner Anamika Aggarwal as well as of complainant Vimal Kumar Aggarwal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that there was only a money dispute between the parties which has been now settled by way of a compromise and that this compromise will go a long way to remove ill-will and hatred between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of the fact that in the connected matter similar compromise has been effected, complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act bearing No.1344 dated 22.8.2009 titled as Vimal Kumar vs. Anamika

Aggarwal etc. pending in the Court of JMIC, Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
