ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.3 dated 06.02.2015 registered under Sections 406/120-B IPC, NRI Police Station Moga, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise dated 02.07.2015 (Annexure P-2), arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Respondent no.2 Harvinder Pal Samra who is the complainant in the afore mentioned FIR, is present in the Court. She states that in lieu of compromise dated 02.07.2015, she had received a sum of Rs.6.5 lac in cash and today she has received a demand draft amounting to Rs.12.5 lacs. She further states that she has no

objection if the present FIR and all other consequential proceedings arisen thereof are quashed.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that there are two other accused in this FIR who are in abroad and respondent no.2 is the only aggrieved person in this FIR.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof are quashed qua the petitioner.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements made in the Court below.
