Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be allowed to withdraw this petition in respect of petitioner No.2 Usman, who has been attributed the injury attracting offence under section 307 IPC. He undertakes that petitioner No.2 shall surrender before the investigating agency/trial court within a week from today.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.2.

Learned State counsel (on the instructions from S.I. Rajbir Singh, who is present in court) submits that pursuant to order dated September 01, 2015, petitioners No.1 and 3 have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated September 01, 2015 is hereby made absolute qua petitioner Nos.1 and 3 namely, Ejaj Khan and Islam, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition qua these petitioners stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
