FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.23 dated 15.03.2015 under Sections 22,25,61,85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

The allegations against the petitioner-Jatinder Kumar in this regular bail application are that on 15.3.2015 he was apprehended on a motorcycle and found in possession of 05 vials of rexcof measuring 500 ml. non-commercial quantity. The learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner is in custody since 15.3.2015 and that even the Investigating Officer has failed to investigate the very allegations of the motorcycle being stolen article.

Learned State counsel though has tried to oppose the bail application but could not controvert the fact that till date no evidence has come on record as to the motorcycle being

subject matter of theft.

In view thereof and keeping in view that the investigations and trial are not likely to be concluded in near future and that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
