The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.39 dated 09.05.2015, under Section 379-B of IPC, registered with Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, the petitioner/accused accompanied by co-accused Dalbir Singh @ Deera intercepted the complainant-Ranjit Kaur and on the point of *Datar* robbed her gold chain.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that the petitioner is in custody since 10.05.2015 and the investigations are over.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from S.I. Satpal, submits that the antecedents of the petitioner are that he does not deserve the concession of bail.

An affidavit dated 21.09.2015 of Sh. Mandeep Singh, DSP, Sub Division Shahkot, District Jalandhar (Rural) was filed wherein it is stated that the petitioner either stands convicted or is facing criminal trials in almost 09 other cases.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.
