JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50 dated 29.03.2015, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

As per the preliminary enquiry conducted in the aforesaid FIR, the petitioner/accused-Gurpreet Singh @ Neelu along with co-accused Hardit Singh have got executed a forged Sale Deed and also prepared forged documents to obtain two loans of Rs.15 Lacs each sanctioned from the bank.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from H.C. Santokh Singh, submits that two of the co-accused have since been arrested and during their investigation also, the alleged role of the petitioner has been surfaced.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties, keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
