Present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail in case bearing FIR No.24 dated 1.3.2015 under Sections 302, 120-B and 34 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Pasiana, District Patiala.

Custody certificate of the petitioner, filed today in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is innocent in the present case. Investigation has already been completed and challan presented in the Court. As per FIR also, the petitioner has not been attributed any specific injury or role in the occurrence. The allegations are against accused Baljinder Singh, who had allegedly fired

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shot and Amandeep Singh and Bhupinder Singh who have already been arrested and they are in custody. The petitioner was named on the basis of suspicion only. He has submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 13.3.2015 and decision of the case still to take some more time. So, the petitioner be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant submitted that the petitioner is the main accused who had arranged funds for commission of the crime. So, his bail application be dismissed.

Having considered the above facts that Baljinder Singh had allegedly fired on Manoj Kanjla [since deceased] and he has already been arrested and even the weapon used for commission of offence in this case has since been recovered. However, no role has been attributed to the petitioner. Petitioner has also taken a plea that on the date of alleged occurrence, he was present in Hero Heart Dayanand Medical College and Hospital, Ludhiana as his mother was undergoing angioplasty and he had signed the consent form also. Petitioner is in custody since 31.3.2015 in this case and trial of the case still to take some more time to complete, petitioner Jagjit Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.
