Report dated 13.3.2015 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Kurukshetra has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Binto and Shambu Parshad as well as of complainant Rajender Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offence for which the petitioners are charged is purely a monetary dispute between the parties and that the compromise will go a long way to sort out difference between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.383 dated 30.9.2014 under Sections 406, 420, 506, 34 IPC Police Station, Shahabad District Kurukshetra and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
