Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of directions issued by this Court on 4.9.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh has affirmed the factum of joining the investigation by the petitioner but opposes the anticipatory bail.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her as neither any suicide note was recovered nor any custodial interrogation is required.

Accordingly, interim order dated 4.9.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
