The instant petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners on the basis that they had entered into matrimony against the wishes of their elders.

While issuing notice of motion on 28.01.2015, this Court had directed respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Verka, District Amritsar to ensure the protection of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Labh Singh, P.S. A-Division, District Amritsar would submit that the statement of petitioner No.1,namely, Anjana has been recorded and she has stated that she is happily staying with her husband i.e Amar-petitioner No.2 and does not require any police protection. This also perhaps explains the non-appearance of the counsel for the petitioners during the course of hearing today.

In the light of categoric stand taken on behalf of the State,
no further directions are required to be passed.

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The instant petition is disposed of as infructuous.
