Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jagraj Singh FIR No.06 dated 27.06.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 406, 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station NRI Bathinda and offences under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC added vide DDR No.14 dated 5.8.2015.

As per the allegations the petitioner is stated to have got transferred in his name a vehicle Tata Safari given to Iqbal Singh at the time of his marriage with the daughter of the complainant.

It is contended that the said Iqbal Singh has through his power of attorney was seeking to transfer the title of the said vehicle in favour of

the petitioner and the said transfer is not disputed by Iqbal Singh, therefore, no case at the behest of the complainant is made out against the present petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has since joined the investigation and has furnished his specimen signatures.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Fauji Ram does not refute the aforesaid situation and submits that petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 02nd of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
