Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 155 dated 26.07.2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 452, 307, 323, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Jagraon Sadar, District Ludhiana.

As per allegations, petitioner alleged to be armed with a *kirpan* gave a blow to the complainant-Darshan Singh on his head after entering the house. Said injury has been opined to be grievous in nature.

It was contended that the FIR was lodged after 20 days of the occurrence and the petitioner who is 18 years old student has been falsely roped in. Even otherwise, there is only a single injury suffered by Darshan Singh.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that after the grant of interim protection by this Court, vide order dated 03.09.2015, the petitioner/accused has since joined the investigations.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Jaspal Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 03.09.2015, is made absolute/confirmed.
