AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for anticipatory bail.

On 04.09.2015 the following order was passed:-

“Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.71 dated 11.05.2015 under Section 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Maqsudan, Jalandhar.

As per allegations in the FIR, there was a secret information to the police that Sukhwinder Singh along with his wife Raji, Tarsem Singh along with his wife Hansi @ Hans Rani (petitioner herein) have formed a gang for smuggling Poppy Husk and they were coming in a White Bolero to supply Poppy Husk in the area of Nangal Salempur.

It is contended that even as per the version in the FIR upon raid being conducted 04 Kg of Poppy Husk is stated to have been recovered from Sukhwinder Singh and one Om Parkash. There is no recovery from the petitioner nor is she found at the spot nor apprehended.

Notice of motion for 08.10.2015.

In the meanwhile, in the event of her arrest, petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer. However, she shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.”

Learned Addl.AG, on instructions from HC Tej Pal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances the order dated 04.09.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
