The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.183, dated 9.7.2015, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148, 149 of the IPC (Section 326 added lateron), at Police Station City Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that apart from the merits of the case, the matter has been compromised.

Learned Addl. A.G Punjab, on instructions from HC Bhupinder Singh, has accepted this factual assertion.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of their arrest, the petitioners

shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
