Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 CrPC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated 14.7.2013 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 read with Section 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that apart from the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner namely Shamsher Singh has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M-653 of 2015 *Shamsher Singh v. State of Punjab*, vide order dated 22.7.2015, the matter has also been compromised between the

parties and on the basis of said compromise, CRM-M-18304 of 2015 *Lakhvir Singh v. State of Punjab & others* has also been filed for quashing of FIR in question, which is pending for 20.11.2015 before this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the offence alleged in the FIR are triable by a Magistrate and the petitioner is in custody since 30.6.2015.

Considering the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties coupled with the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 30.6.2015, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.
