Petitioners apprehend arrest in a case registered at the instance of Gurbej Singh alleging that the petitioners along with six others armed with 'kirpan', 'dattar' and 'dangs' had trespassed in the house of the complainant and attacked him, his father Karam Singh and caused grievous injuries.

Prima facie, it appears debatable whether the bone cut injury on the arm of Gurbej Singh would be grievous as no fracture had been seen in the injury.

With the assistance of learned State counsel, I have gone through the police file which indicates that x-ray does not show any fracture on the person of complainant Gurbej Singh. Even otherwise, the matter has been compromised and a petition for quashing on the basis of compromise has been filed.

Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the matter has actually been compromised.

In view of said circumstances, the petitioners can be granted concession of pre-arrest bail especially when they have already joined investigation.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 03.09.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
