This order shall dispose of aforementioned two petitions bearing CRM-M No. 29772 of 2014, titled as "Bakshish Singh and Others Versus State of Punjab and Another" and CRM-M No. 29769 of 2014, titled as "Harsimran Singh and Others Versus State of Punjab and Another", as both these petitions have arisen out of the same occurrence.

Both the above mentioned petitions have been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No. 53,

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dated 22.03.2014, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 427 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station-Dina Nagar, District Gurdaspur and its cross version recorded in the above said FIR on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

Report from the trial Court has been received in both cases, in which it is mentioned that parties have arrived at a compromise.

Learned counsel for the parties have also stated at the bar that the matter has been compromised between the parties. It was a personal dispute which has been amicably settled.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, “**Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others**” 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the above said FIR and its cross version stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR and its cross version also stands quashed.
