JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.226 dated 09.07.2015, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34, IPC and Section 3(X) of the S.C. and S.T. Act, registered with Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal.

It is submitted that all the offences are bailable except one under the S.C./S.T. Act.

It is contended that the petitioners are in custody since 14.07.2015 and a false case regarding allegation under the SC/ST Act has been foisted upon the petitioners to make the case non-bailable.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that co-accused Amit, who has been attributed similar role has since been granted regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 20.08.2015 and, therefore, claims parity of treatment.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar, concedes that the investigation qua the petitioners is over, as also the fact of grant of regular bail to the co-accused Amit.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts of the case as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioners/accused-Robin and Mohra @ Sonu deserve the concession of regular bail and as such they are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.
