Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.53 dated 12.08.2014, under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sanaur, District Patiala.

Following order was passed by this Court on 14.10.2014:-

“Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hans Raj, has submitted that Tej Partap, who had been authorised by the original owner-Kuldip Kaur, has suffered a statement during investigation that he will execute the sale deed qua the remaining plots in favour of the complainant.

List again on 15.1.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Sukhdev Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 14.10.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
