Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.165 dated 25.06.2015, under Sections 420, 406, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Heard.

Prosecution story in brief is that petitioner along with his wife went to the house of the complainant-Madan Lal in April 2014 and assured that in case, they invest money in their company, they would be getting monthly interest at the rate of 6%. Complainant and his wife gave ₹7,00,000/- to the petitioner, who further handed over the same to his wife-Meena Rani and she kept the same in her purse.

In the present case, allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. Petition filed by Meena Rani, co-accused of the petitioner for anticipatory bail, was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 20.08.2015. Petitioner might be required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the seriousness of allegations levelled against the petitioner, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made out.
