After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise all their pleas before the trial court at the appropriate stage. He, however, prays that personal appearance of petitioners No.5 and 6 before the trial court, who are college going students, may be exempted.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. In case the petitioners No.5 and 6 move an application for exemption of their personal appearance, the same shall be considered by the court below in accordance with law. The trial court may consider exempting personal appearance of these petitioners except on the dates it is necessary.
