Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in cross-version case registered vide DDR No.27 dated 20.12.2014 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 308, 326 IPC were added later on) in FIR No.64 dated 19.12.2014 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 307, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, Police Station Dhilwan Kapurthala, submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation.

In view of the above, instant petition is allowed and the order dated 04.09.2015 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
