MAHESH GROVER, J (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the cross version in case FIR No. 83 dated 26.04.2005, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 and 325 (added lateron) IPC at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the ground that co-accused, who has faced the trial has since been acquitted.

The petitioner himself is a proclaimed offender.

If that is so, then there is no reason to accept the prayer of the petitioner who is fugitive from law. However, considering the fact that the petitioner has expressed his willingness to follow the process of law, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction that the petitioner would submit himself to the jurisdiction of the learned trial Court on or before 07.04.2015. In case he does so and makes a prayer for regular bail, the learned trial Court shall consider the same and dispose it off as expeditiously

as possible but not later than two days from the date of filing of the application. It would also make an endeavour to conclude the trial by taking into consideration all the facts cumulatively.
