RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks directions to the official respondents to conduct proper, fair, impartial and expeditious investigation in FIR No. 54 dated 12.02.2014 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, status report by way of affidavit dated 20.03.2015 has been filed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhminder Singh, Police Station City, District Ferozepur, submits that during pendency of the present petition, an effective and impartial investigation was conducted by Superintendent of Police (HQ), Ferozepur. As a result of the investigation conducted, offence under Section 307 IPC

has been deleted, because as per the medical report of the petitioner, all the injuries were found simple in nature. She further submits that now investigation is over and based on that, cancellation report is being prepared because none of the allegations levelled by the petitioner have been found to be substantiated. She prays for disposal of the present petition, as no further orders are warranted.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let the present petition be disposed of in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to pursue his other remedies, in accordance with law.

In view of the abovesaid respective stands taken, present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, however, with liberty as prayed for.
