This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 379, 427 IPC and Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 at Police Station Sadar Moga, vide FIR No.80 dated 16.8.2015.

Learned State counsel (on the instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, who is present in court) submits that pursuant to order dated September 04, 2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated September 04, 2015 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
