This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint No.77 dated 22.05.2010 under Sections 438, 452, 324, 436, 506, 147, 148, 149 IPC pending in the trial Court, Ropar.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court on the date fixed and move an application for regular

bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case within 2 days on merits. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender before the Court in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
