This order shall dispose of CWP Nos. 9090, 9114 of 2004. Both the petitioners are working on daily wages in the Forest Department, Haryana. In the present petitions they have challenged the retrenchment notice dated 14.5.2004. They have also sought regularization of their services. At the time of issuance of notice of motion in the year 2004, operation of the notice dated 14.5.2004, was stayed and the petitioners were allowed to continue in service till the

next date of hearing.

We have been informed that both the petitioners are still working. The issue of their retrenchment has not been considered and decided by the Competent Authority, as they have approached this Court against the notice and the operation of the notice was stayed.

In view of the above facts, after hearing learned counsel for the parties, we dispose of this writ petition with liberty to the respondents to consider and decide the retrenchment notice issued by them after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and pass a speaking order.

In case the petitioners are ordered to continue in service their claim for regularization be also considered. Till final decision is taken in this regard by the respondents, the petitioners will continue in services.

These petitions are accordingly disposed of.
