Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC read with Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983 (later on added offence under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, vide order dated 23.07.2014) in a case arising out of FIR No.108 dated 11.08.2011, registered at Police Station Phase-1 District Mohali.

As per the allegations, the petitioner along with co-accused had duped one Varinder Kumar of huge amount of Rs.16,82,000/- on the pretext of sending him abroad through placement agency namely Jet International Immigration Placement Services and forged some documents and in this background the FIR was registered.

31 cases have been registered against the petitioner and she is on bail in all the cases. This fact has been taken into notice while declining bail to her on 17.12.2014.

At this stage, reference can be made to order dated 24.01.2014 passed in CRM-M-2003 of 2014, vide which the petitioner was granted regular bail keeping in view that she is in jail with a small child.

Counsel for the petitioner has further stated that she is residing in Sector 21, Panchkula and she has no concern with her husband Deepak Arora, who is living separately. She is custody since 21.07.2012.

Keeping in view the above facts, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mohali.
