Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.202 dated 11.7.2014, under Sections 15, 27, 29, 61 and 85 of the NDPS Act and under Sections 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Dabwali, District Sirsa.

While recording the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court has passed the following order on 30.1.2015 :-

“Learned counsel has referred to statement of Vikram Singh (P-2) whereby he has named one Rahul @ Nasirudin son of Bhawar Singh Kalal, who is having a factory near the place of occurrence. But the police

want to implicate the present petitioner i.e. Rahul Ali son of Maohammad Ali and there is no factory of the present petitioner.

Issue notice of motion to the respondents, returnable for 13.2.2015.

Till the next date of hearing, the petitioner shall not be arrested.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 30.1.2015 and subsequent order dated 29.10.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Sugreev Kumar has stated that in view of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.1.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
