Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

Grouse of the petitioner is that repeated inquiries are being held against him and that the official respondents be directed not to conduct further inquiry except on the direction of the Director General of Police, Punjab as per instructions dated 1.4.2008.

State has filed reply. It comes out that three inquiries were conducted. This Court is not concerned with the result of the inquiries. The police is always at liberty to take action in consequence to the inquiries. However, repeated inquiries are contrary to the instructions of the Director General of Police, Punjab.

In the circumstances, I order that in future if on the basis of same or similar complaint an inquiry is to be conducted, that will be conducted only with the permission of the Director General of Police, Punjab.

The petition is disposed of.
