Learned counsel for the parties have not made available statement of the prosecutrix made in the Court.

Petitioner along with other co-accused is alleged to have kidnapped the sister of the complainant on 28.05.2013 whereas she was recovered on 22.06.2014. The allegations against the petitioner is that he along with other accused had kidnapped the prosecutrix for the purpose of forcing her into prostitution.

Co-accused of the petitioner are on bail and the prosecutrix is stated to have already been examined.

On the principle of parity and taking into consideration the stage of the trial, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
