ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

Respondents No.4 and 5 have appeared before the Court
and they have given time to talk with the petitioners.

No proof with regard to age of petitioner No.1 has been
placed on record by the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that as verified from
Registrar of Births and Deaths, petitioner No.1 is minor and her date of
birth is 25.04.1999 and a case has been registered against petitioner
No.2.

The petitioners have claimed that they have married against
the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6. They apprehend danger to their
life from them. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated
02.09.2015, Annexure P-5 to respondent nos.2 and 3.

Without commenting upon the legality of the marriage and entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent no.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-5 within a period of one month and grant the protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
