The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.'), having been summoned under Section 193 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.281 dated 25.11.2013, registered under Sections 306, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Kapurthala City, Distt. Kapurthala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the married-sister-in-law. She was found innocent in the investigating carried out by the police. Further contends that even in the complaint, the allegations of killing the daughter of the complainant have not been levelled against her. In pursuance of order dated 07.10.2014, the petitioner has furnished bail bonds, which stand

accepted, vide order dated 13.10.2014. A certified copy of the order dated 13.10.2014, has been filed in the Court, which is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, order dated 07.10.2014, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
